

## Corrigendum

In reference to the Advertisement Notice for Walk-in-Interview for the post of TGT, Phy. Training cum Mobility Instructor & Asstt. Teachers issued on 11 Nov 2013, the following amendments are issued:-

The Qualification of TGT should be read as “Degree of Spl. B.Ed. from Recognized University or equivalent” in place of “Degree of B.Ed. from Recognized University or equivalent”

Qualification of Phy. Trg. cum Mobility Instructor shall be as per Recruitment Rules i.e. **Annexure-I**.

Preference shall be given to the candidates who are qualified in Central Teachers Eligibility Test (CTET).

It should be read as “Appointment as Guest Teachers for a period of 3 months in the GSSSBB, Sewa Kutir, K. Camp, Delhi” in place of “Appointment as Guest Teachers for a period of 3 months in the Sarvodaya Schools of Delhi”.
