Applications are invited from eligible and interested persons for appointment as Deputy Commissioner (Persons with Disabilities) under the provisions of Section 60(4) of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and full Participation) act, 1995 and Delhi Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and full Participation) Rules, 2001.

The eligibility criteria for the post is that the person should have educational background in Social Work, Sociology or Social Anthropology with 7 years experience in Rehabilitation Work.

NOTIFICATION

NO. F. 10(89)/2012/DSW/ Estt. :- In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 73 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (1 of 1996) read with Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. S.O. 24(E) dated the 5th December, 1997, the Lt. Governor of National Capital Territory of Delhi, hereby makes the following rules to amend the Delhi Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation), Rules, 2001, namely:-

1. Short title and Commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Delhi Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Amendment Rules, 2013.

2. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Delhi Gazette.

3. Amendment of rule 48- In the Delhi Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Rules 2001, in rule 48, after rule 48(B), the following shall be inserted, namely:-

48 (C) Terms and Conditions of appointment to the post of Deputy Commissioner (Disabilities):-

- (i) He/She should not have attained the age of 62 years.
- (ii) If he/she is in a service under the Central Government or State Government, he/she shall seek retirement from such service before his/her appointment to the post.
- (iii) The Deputy Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities shall be appointed on full time basis for a period of three years from the date he/she resumes office or till he/she attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier. A person may serve as a Deputy Commissioner for a maximum of two terms, subject to the upper age limit of 65 years.
- (iv) The post of Deputy Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities is in the scale of Rs. 15600-39100+ GP- 6600/-.
- (v) In the case of a retired Government servant, the pay will be fixed in accordance with the formula of last pay drawn minus pension.
- (vi) Persons holding existing analogous posts are eligible for filling the post of Deputy Commissioner (Disabilities) on deputation duly recommended by the Search-cum-Selection Committee.
- (vii) Leave- He/she shall be entitled to such leave as is admissible to Government servants under the Central Civil Service (leave) Rules, 1972.
- (viii) Leave Travel Concession: - He /she shall be entitled to such leave travel concession as per norms.
- (ix) Medical benefits:- He/she shall be entitled to such medical benefits as is admissible to the Officers under Delhi Government Employees Health Scheme (DGEHS).

TA and DA :- He/she shall be entitled to travelling allowance and daily allowance on tour as per norms.

(xi) A Search-cum-Selection Committee headed by Chief Secretary, Government of NCT of Delhi and consisting of Principal Secretary (Services), Secretary (Health and Family Welfare), Secretary (Social Welfare and WCD) and Director (Social Welfare) shall recommend name of the Deputy Commissioner (Disabilities) to Hon'ble L.G. for appointment.

(xii) **Resignation and Removal** (1) The Deputy Commissioner (Disabilities) may, by notice in writing, addressed to the State Government resign from his/her post. The period of such notice shall be one month.

(2) The State Government shall remove a person from the office of the Deputy Commissioner (Disabilities) if he/she

(a) becomes an insolvent.

(b) engages during his/her term of office in any paid employment outside the duties of his/her office.

(c) gets convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for an offence.

(d) is in the opinion of the State Government, unfit to continue in office due to reasons of infirmity of mind or body or serious default in the performance of office functions as laid down in the Act.

(e) without obtaining leave of absence from the State Government, remains and absent from duty for a consecutive period of fifteen days or more, or

(f) has, in the opinion of the State Government, so abused the position of the Deputy Commissioner (Disabilities) as to render his continuance in office detrimental to the interest of persons with disabilities or


(g) Violates the provision of Rule 3 of CCS (conduct) rules 1964.

Provided that no person shall be removed under this rule except after following the procedure, mutatis mutandis, prescribed for removal of a Group A employee of the Central Government under CCS (CCA) Rules 1965.

(3) The State Government may suspend the Deputy Commissioner (Disabilities), in respect of whom proceedings for removal have been commenced in accordance with sub-rule(2), pending conclusion of such proceedings.

(xiii) **Residuary Provision:-** Conditions of service of the Deputy Commissioner (Disabilities) in respect of which no express provision has been made in these rules shall be referred in each case to the State Government for its decision and the decision of the Government shall be binding.
