

Column No. of the Schedule	Provisions of RRs agreed to by Services Department
7. (Educational and other qualification required for direct recruits)	<p><b><u>Essential :</u></b></p> <p>(i) Master's degree of a recognized University or equivalent.</p> <p>(ii) B.Ed Special Education in Hearing Impairment (B.Ed. Spl. Ed. (HI)) from an Institute recognized by RCI.</p> <p>(iii) 10 years teaching experience in a Government or Voluntary Institution for the hearing impaired.</p> <p>(iv) The applicant should possess a valid RCI registration certificate as Rehabilitation professional.</p> <p>(v) Knowledge of Sign language. If the person does not know sign language, but is otherwise qualified and eligible, if selected for the post, he/she must compulsorily undergo a course for learning sign language from an institute recognized by RCI within six months of joining the post.</p> <p><b><u>Desirable: -</u></b></p> <p>(i) Experience as Head of Training Institute or Administrative incharge of Institute for Hearing Impaired.</p> <p>(ii) Knowledge of Hindi.</p> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <p>1). Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the UPSC in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.</p> <p>2). The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the UPSC in the case of candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, if at any stage of selection, the UPSC is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.</p>

Note: Amendment of the provision in Col. No. 7 'Educational and other qualification required for direct recruits' has been made in pursuant to the observation of UPSC and for replacing the word "Deaf and Dumb" with Hearing Impaired as per provision laid in RPwD Act, 2016.

Rest of the contents of the draft notification alongwith other column of the schedule as uploaded vide this office letter no.F.10(390)/2019/A-I/DSW/Estt./RRs/1773 dated 19.12.2019 remains unchanged.
